Upon County. I Nelson Palham of said State & County
being of advanced age & knowing that I must shortly depart
this life, deem it right & proper both as respects my family &
myself that I should make a disposition of the property with
which a kind Providence has blessed me. Do therefore make
this my Last Will & Testament hereby revoking all others
herebefore made by me.

1st. I desire & direct that my body be buried in a decent Christian
manner, suitable to my circumstances & condition in life.
My soul I trust shall return to rest with God who gave it, &
I hope for eternal salvation through the merits of the covenant of
the blessed Lord & Saviour Jesus Christ whose religion I have
professed & as I hope, I have enjoyed for a number of years.

2^d. I desire that one lot of land No. twelve hundred & eighty two
in the Nineteenth district Second Section in Cherokee County
containing forty acres should be sold of all my just debts be paid.

3. I give bequeath & devise to my beloved wife Valinda for &
during her natural life 'only' my lot of land that I now
live on No forty five in the Fifteenth district of formerly Houston
but now Upson County containing two hundred two & a half
acres, also two thirds of lot of land No Six in the Fifteenth district
of formerly Houston but now Upson County containing one hundred
& thirty five acres with all the rights members & appurtenances
to said lands. I also give & bequeath to my beloved wife
in the same reserved manner the farming utensils used on &
belonging to said plantation of every description whatever,
and two horses & one mule & all my stock of cattle, hogs, & all
my corn, fodder, bacon, household & kitchen furniture of every
description belonging to & used on said plantation; also my
 negro woman Hattie about forty years of age, my negro
boy Joe twelve years of age &

4. I give bequeath & devise to my two sons George & and Austin
73. one lot of land No fifty eight (58). in the Fifteenth district
of formerly Houston now Upson County) containing two hundred
two & a half acres, also seventy & a half acres of lot No forty three
in the fifteenth district formerly Houston now Upson County, known
as the Herriman lands, with all the rights members & privileges
to said lands in any way appertaining or belonging thereto.

5. I give bequeath & devise to my son James one third of lot of land
No six in the fifteenth district of formerly Houston now Upson County
containing sixty seven acres with all the rights members & privileges

to said land in any wise appertaining or belonging forever -
8. I give bequeath & devise to my Daughter Margiana A. Clary
one lot of land No Eight (8) in the fifth district of Carroll County
containing two hundred two & a half acres, with all the rights, members,
& privileges to said lot of land in any wise appertaining or belonging forever.
9. I give bequeath & devise to my Seven Oldest Children, namely -
William, James, John, Nancy Flanigan, Ruthy Squars,
Elizabeth King & Sarah Headwine three lots of land
namely, one lot No Fourteen in the Seventh district of the County of
Appomattox containing four hundred & Ninety acres, also, one other lot
No Seventy Nine in the first district of the County of Roanoke containing
four hundred & Ninety acres, also one other lot No Eleven hundred
& Fifty nine in the Second district, Fourth Section Charlotte County
containing forty acres with all the rights, members, & privileges to
said lots of land in any wise appertaining or belonging forever.
10. The residue of my property both Real & personal, Where ever &
what ever it may be including that given to my beloved wife
Valinda during her natural life, after estate thereon is over - I
give bequeath & devise to my Son David J. forever.

I furthermore desire & devise that my Son David J. should
be raised & supported & well educated from the proceeds of
the property bequeathed to my wife & my Son David J.

11. I hereby constitute & appoint my worthy friend O. C. Gibson
Executor of this my last will & Testament this 8th day of May 1848.
