I Patrick S. Holloway of said County, in view of my departure from this life, do make & ordain this writing to be my last will & Testament Chaffy - I command my Soul to the mercy of him who gave it and I desire to be buried in decent Christian burial -

Item - My Will is that my just debts be all paid within a reasonable time after my death, and for that purpose hereby authorize and direct my Executor to sell my negro man Bill & to apply the proceeds of my Crop (Surplus, over support) & of said negro to the payment of the same, together with <sup>the</sup> the note of accounts that may be due; and if this is not enough then I wish my lot of land number Ninety five that lays west of my house lot sold, but not until it is necessary -

Item - My Will & desire is that my wife Martha H. and my Children remain together with all my property not sold to pay my debts on my farm; And that my Executors have authority to conduct the farm so as to support my family & educate my Children & such to give them as little trouble as possible I hereby direct that no accounts be kept or required of the purchase & sale of small articles such as are usually bought & sold on the farm, but let them return all balances of Crops that may be annually on hand

Item - Supposing that it may be possible that my wife may at some time desire to change her residence, I hereby authorize my Executors to sell the settlement of land I now reside on & with the proceeds of such sale purchase another farm, ensuring through that said sale & purchase be a proper & prudential in view of the interest of my family -

Item - My will & desire is that my Children all share equal & alike in the portions of my estate that they may receive & whenever one shall become twenty one years old or marry. I hereby give them an equal share (including my beloved wife Martha H. as an heir) and which share my Executor shall allot to my Children at the time above named out of such property at a fair valuation as will be suitable considering the interests of all,

Item - I give & bequeath to my beloved wife Martha H. a Chaffey part of all my estate, this to include her right of Dowry.

Item - If my beloved wife Martha H. should marry then I wish to direct my Executor as soon thereafter as will be practicable to sell all my estate & divide the same equally between my said wife and Children -

Item - I hereby nominate & appoint my beloved wife Martha H. Holloway and my Father in Law Thomas S. Parkinson, executors.
