testament, most cheerfully I commend my soul to him
who gave it, and my body to the earth in plain and
Christian like burial,-

Item 1st I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife One negro man
named Isaac, and his wife named Mary and their two youngest
children Ellen and Burwell, One negro woman named Lolla and
negro boy by the name of Green, also One lot of land whereon
I now live No Ninety four (94) in the tenth district of
originally Monroe now Upson County, also One Sout. Wagon
One Robn Horse & my Saddle Horse, also all the house
hold and Kitchen furniture and as much of the stock
of all kind that I have as she may want, also as
much provision as she may stand in need of for twelve
months, the pleasure Cabbage, and as many of the farming
tools as will answer to carry on a farm for the property
so willed her,-

Item 2nd I give and bequeath to my daughter Edney Edwards One
negro Girl named America -

Item 3rd I give and bequeath to my Grand daughter Caroline Garland
One Feather Bed, bedstead and furniture,

Item 4th I appoint that the balance of my property not devised
to my wife, Edney Edwards, and Grand daughter Caroline
Garland, be sold and after paying my just debts, and
funeral expenses, shall be equally divided between
my lawful heirs (by) Paul Holloway, Patrick S. Holloway,
Edney Edwards, Elizabeth Garland Children, 4th Edward Children
Francis, George & Children, Louisa & Children, Children and
my son Edward Holloway, Child Edward C. Holloway.

Item 5th I hereby nominate and appoint my two sons Paul
Holloway & Patrick S. Holloway Executors of this my
last will & testament

have hereunto set my hand and Seal this thirtieth day of
January in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred
& forty One - (1841)
