and personal and to dispose of the Crop to the best payment of
demands against the estate I also request my Brother Joseph to
have a sale of all of my estate both real and personal in the
fall of the year after the Crop is disposed of to the best of his
Judgment. I also wish my estate to be equally divided after paying
all of my just debts, between my dear wife Mary Ann Vena and
all of my Children, Elie Bradford, Maranda, John Robert,
Greene Washington Bartlesdale, Mary Brantly, and the other not yet
born, with the Exception of my son John Robert, I give him two
portions, or shares of my estate more than the rest of my Children
I also wish my son Elie Bradford and my daughter Maranda to be
disposed of to the best of my Brother Joseph's Judgment. this the
twenty eighth day of March eighteen hundred and forty three -
