in manner and form following, Viz-

- Item 1st I give and bequeath unto my wife Lucy the
following property To wit, Peter, Nelson and Vama,
one Mare Mule called Nell, one saddle Mare, two Cows and
Calves, one Road Wagon, one yoke of Oxen, Twenty five head
of Hogs first Choice, the flock of Sheep, all the House hold and
Kitchen furniture, Cotton Gin & Ginning Press, Fan and Threshing
Machine, my new Carry all, plantation Tools, and one years
provision. All this I give and bequeath to my wife for
life time, and then to be equally divided between my Children;
- Item 2nd Mary Hudman has received five hundred dollars
in part of her legacy of my Estate;
- Item 3rd Nancy Meadows has received Four hundred twelve
and a half dollars in part of her legacy of my Estate;
- Item 4th Faytha Park has received Three hundred eighty seven
and a half dollars in part of her legacy of my Estate;
- Item 5th Stephen Parker has received Six hundred ninety two
and half dollars in part of his legacy of my Estate;
- Item 6th Daniel Parker Junr has received five hundred seventy
six & a half dollars in part of his legacy of my Estate;
- Item 7th Philoman Parker has received Six hundred ninety two
and half dollars in part of his legacy of my Estate;
- Item 8th Sherwood Parker has had Six hundred seventeen and
a half dollars in part of his legacy of my Estate;
- Item 9th Lucy Parker has had two Bees and Cow & Calf in part
of her legacy of my Estate amounting to thirty seven dollars &
a half and I also give and bequeath unto the said Lucy one
a Negro Man over and above and equal proportion with the
rest of the Legates;
- Item 10th Thomas Parker has had Six hundred seventeen and a
half dollars in part of his legacy of my Estate;
- Item 11th Susannah Meadows has had Four hundred eighty seven
and half dollars in part of her legacy of my Estate;
- Item 12th And when each of the Legates part is made up equal
to the highest then the balance of my Estate to be equally
divided among my Children;
- Item 13th I constitute nominate and appoint William Price
and Septia F. Walker my sole Executors of this my

last Will and Testament hereby revoking all other and former
Wills by me at any time heretofore made
