I Sulton Hardy being in full health but of
sound mind do make this my last Will and Testament. I
dedicate my soul to God who gave it and my body to the dust
from whence it came.
I wish William Hardy & Isaac Hardy to act as my lawful ad-
ministrators I wish all of my just debts paid out of the proceeds
of my pleasant crop of cotton and if it should fail to pay all
of my just debts I wish enough of my stock sold to make up
the deficit. I do will and bequeath unto my dear beloved wife
Elizabeth Hardy all of my land that I am now living upon
to gether with all the stock and all other property of what so ever
name it may be belonging to the premises, after the payment of
all of my just debts to my wife Elizabeth during her natural
life time and at her death I wish the Land stock and all other
property belonging to the premises sold and divided equally among
all of my lawful begotten children by my wife Elizabeth Hardy
and my six children that is now living with me & John Hardy
Adalind Hardy Charles Hardy Susan Hardy Thomas Hardy
and Anna Hardy as they become of age or marry to receive as
much as I have given to my children that has left me
