this my last will and Testament Testt.

Item. I desire that whatever of Land, negroes, or other property of any
kind that I possess after the Payment of all my just debts, rest and
remain in the possession under the Control of my beloved wife
Nancy for and during the term of her natural life or widowhood
for the purpose of bearing, and supporting all my Children of marriage
without Charge.

Item. In the event of the death or intermarriage of my Wif. Nancy
I desire that all of my property and effects, be thrown into one
Common Estt and distributed equally between my Wif. Nancy
Head, Elizabeth Brooks, Nancy Head, Permelia Head, Sherman Head,
William Head, Martha Head, Lucy Anna Head, John Head & James Head.
I desire that all notes and accounts that I possess be first
applied to the Payment of my just debts, and if the notes and
accounts are insufficient for the same, my Executors will pay the
remainder of my debts, by diminishing of such property as will be the
least, injurious to the Estt. In testimony whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and affixed my seal this 17th of January
Eighteen hundred and Ninety two.

I do hereby appoint Alfrida Ferguson of the County of Upson
& my Wif. Nancy as executors and Executrix of this my last will
& Testament.) John Head
