I William Miller Sr. of the County of Union & State aforesaid do make & ordain this my last Will & Testament in the manner & form as following:

- Item 1. I resign my Soul and Body to God who gave it & desire that my body should be decently buried.
- Item 2. I give & bequeath unto my beloved wife Elizabeth Miller and Elizabeth Owens and Sarah Miller And Reuben Miller all the Land and possessions which on I now lie upon containing two hundred acres and a half acres.
- Item 3. My will further is that my Estate of Servants and other property consisting of personal property to be equally divided among my lawful heirs and after the death of Elizabeth Miller my wife her part to go back to Elizabeth Owens and Sarah Miller and Reuben Miller her part of the Land, and Elizabeth Miller my beloved wife and sonas Miller and Isham Miller to carry into effect and execute this last will and Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the day and year above written.
