 I also give and bequeath to my wife my bay horse and buggy
 horse known as the horse I bought of Jerry Blackwell I
 bequeath out other cow named Silly and calf and yearling.
 Third - I give and bequeath to my beloved son Willard
 acres of land known as the land the old Methodist Church
 used to stand on. I give and bequeath to my son my buggy
 horse Selma and Red cow and calf - all my farming tools, wagon
 and oxen. I give and bequeath to my son my library, book case
 and secretary and all my medicine shop furniture and every
 thing pertaining thereto and besides and bidding that stands
 in my shop room and in the equine yard.

And fourth - It is my will that my young iron gray horse
 remain on the farm as a work horse until crop is raised
 by and my son to sell to the best advantage and pay the
 debt I owe Blackwell for the bay horse, and what is left
 over to be equally divided between my wife and son.

I also give and bequeath to my wife and each my household and kitchen furnished cooking ware, linen, silver and the crib corn in the mill wheat in the mill my professional accounts mill accounts, horse ship to be equally divided after paying all my just debts and the ready money on hand after paying my burial expenses to be equally divided

I find it is my will that the debt Caroline Sumner owes me be disposed as follows half of it I allow her for the use of her timber cut and the other half I give her for the kindness and attention she has paid me while sick in sickness whereof I set my hand and seal this 16th day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty one.
