First - I desire and direct that my body be buried in a decent and christianlike manner, suitable to my circumstances and condition in life.

Second - I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid out of my estate by my executor hereinafter made and appointed.

Third - I bequeath and give unto my beloved daughter Virginia Shiko all my estate both personal and real situated and being the state aforesaid and also all my estate Real and personal in the county of Hamilton and State of Tennessee. My said estate Real and personal to be owned absolutely and vested in the aforesaid Virginia Shiko for her sole use and benefit free from the control of any husband of the said Virginia Shiko forever in fee simple.

Fourth - I hereby appoint my trustworthy friend Isaac Stibb and guardian of the person and property of my said minor daughter Shiko

Fifth - I hereby constitute and appoint my friend Isaac Stibb and executor of this my last will and Testament: This the 8th day of March 1884
