Item 1st It is my will that my wife Edney shall have the
use and control of all my property both real &
personal, of every description during her life
or widowhood

Item 2nd But should my said wife Edney marry again
it is my will that all my property be sold and
all the proceeds be equally divided between my
wife and my eight children or their heirs. To-
wit: The children of Willis Newton deceased, Mary
Francis, Emaline Savina and her children, the
Widow of James Mills, Eliza A. Joseph Hunter
Melinda Amanda, Emily Elizabeth and Jacob
J. M. Chalkley, but as my daughter Mary
Francis has been crippled I desire that in
the final distribution of my estate she shall
receive two hundred dollars besides her equal
share

Item 3rd It is my will, that at the final distribution
of my estate, my children who shall have re-
ceived advancements, from me or after my death
from my wife shall account to my Executors
for the same (except my daughter who shall
not account for the bed clothing made by
themselves, nor shall any of the children account
for the bed clothing they have or may receive
And for the purpose of carrying out this will
I hereby appoint my wife Edney, James Trux
and F. M. Young and my son Jacob, J. M. Chalkley
Executors of this my last will
