2nd - It is my will that the land be reserved for the support
of my wife Sarah, and my two children Alonzo & Alced until
the children attain to the age of twenty one years; my wife Sarah
shall have the privilege of living on the place with the children
and shall control the place until she marries, then the chil-

Walker County, Ga. Last Will and Testament of John H. Chapman
February 27th 1883.

I, John H. Chapman being weak in body though
otherwise in my right mind do make this my last will and tes-
tament.

I do direct - I bequeath the 2 lots of land whereon I now live and
negroes to wit: Mary, a girl 14 years of age, Allen a boy 10 years
of age, Lewis a boy 7 years old to Lucy Chapman and all the pro-
perty belonging to me both real and personal to pay all demands
against me, of my effects and then to keep the balance and raise
and educate my children as her judgment may dictate, and to
give off to my children as they become of age as her judgment
may dictate: Provided she retain her maidenhood; but if she
marry, all my property to be sold and equal division be made
to all my children and my wife to receive a child's part.

In witness I have hereunto set my hand and seal, this day
and date above written. I further appoint my son Willie and
Chapman my executor to carry out the contents of this will.
