 to us or may be born, names as follows, Samuel D.

 marry again, the said lands and property shall remain
 in the property of my children I also further give
 all of the remainder of my property to my wife with the
 same exception as of my lands except that she has
 the right to sell or transact any of the perishable
 property or produce of the farm for the purpose of
 paying debts and current expenses of the family and
 give all the children as good education as the law en-
 forces will admit & further give my son Sam D.
 Woods one horse, mule tools as his expense and in divided
 real property provided he remains with his mother or
 the other children till he become 21 years old.
