family, that I should dispose of the small amount of
property with which a kind providence has blessed me. I
do therefore make this my last will and Testament
1st I devise and direct that all my just debts be paid
without delay by my Executor herein after named and
appointed

2nd I give, Bequeath and devise to my beloved wife Martha M. Woods
all of the Tract of Land I now live upon on Summers and
turning across more or less part of Lot of Land no 282 in
the 8th dist and 4th section of Walker County her natural life
time and should she die before the youngest child comes of
age, the said land shall not be sold till the youngest
child becomes of age, and at the death of my wife the
said lands and all property of my children that is born
to us or may be born, I name as follows, Samuel, D.
Sarah, E. Mary, E. Rob Woods And should my wife
marry again, the said lands and property shall remain
in the property of my children I also further give
all of the remainder of my property to my wife with the
same condition as of my lands except that she has
the right to sell or transfer any of the perishable
property or produce of the farm for the purpose of
paying debts and current expenses of the family and
give all the children as good education as her cir-
cumstances will admit. I further give my son Saml D.
Woods one horse, mule, tools - as he separates and received
real property provided he remains with his mother or
the other children till he become 21 years old

I hereby constitute and appoint my friend Mr. William T
my wife Martha M. Woods Executors of this my last will
and Testament This 5 day of November 1883
