 State and County aforesaid, being very sick
 and weak in body but of perfect mind & memory

 the mortality of my body, and knowing that it is
 appointed for all men to die do make and ordain
 this my last will and Testament in the following
 form that is to say principally and firstly of all
 I give and Recommend my soul to God who gave
 it and my body to the clerts to be buried in
 a decent manner at the discretion of my
 family, and for such worldly goods and hath
 bequeathed God to bless me with in this life -
 dispose of in the following manner, and first
 I order and ordain that all my just debts and
 funeral expences be first paid; and secondly
 and lastly I give and bequeath the remaining
 part unto my wife Martha during her life
 and then to be disposed of at her Discretion
 in Witness whereof I have hereunto put my
 hand and fixed my Seal this day and date
 above written, in presence of us
