 Item hth It is my will that the money arising from the sale of my land be equally
 divided between my three children, Green A. Malcom, Mary A. Malcom, and James
 James R. Malcom.
- Item 5th It is my will that my beds and Bed Clothing be equally divided between my four children, Elizabeth C. Anderson, Green A. Malcom, Mary A. Falcom and J James R. Malcom, without being sold.
- Item 6th It is my will that the money arising from the sale of the residue of my property, or that may be on hand at my death. After paying the expenses of Administration my burial expenses etc. be equally divided between my four children Elizabeth C., Green A. Mary A., and James R. and my eight Grand children Mary L. Still, Emily Pannel, James M. Humphrey, Mary A. Young, Frances Anderson, Marion Anderson, John Anderson and William Anderson. My daughter Elizabeth C.
