June 1st 1781. It is my Will and wish for all property to be kept together for the benefit of my wife Elizabeth Parson and her Children, for the Children to be raised and Educated out of the ordinary income of the Same and my Sons more Especially I want them to be given good Educations, and my Daughters what may be deemed Sufficient.

Item 2nd & 3. It is my Will that when any of my Children Comes of age or Marries that so much be given to them as my Executor may think Can be Spared from my property, with propriety so as not to injure the same in any manner, that will prevent the remainder of ~~my~~ Children from receiving an Education Equall to the others if their Capacity will admit —

Henceforth It is my will and wish that my
 wife Elizabeth Markie; then in that case an equal
 Division between her and all my surviving Children
 of all my Real and personal Estate

It is my wish & wish that if any of
my Children marry, and live with ^{me} after that
then in that Case for my property to return back
to my Surviving Children.

Item 5th It is my will that at the death of my wife Elizabeth for an Equal Division to take place of all my property both real & personal between my Surviving Children
