Item third. I give and bequeath to my faithful colored friend Charles Rawles, fifty acres of land on lot number 1 one 7th district of Coffee County on the east line adjoining Wiley Hollans land for acres are way and ten the other.

Item fourth. I desire that all the balance of my property - that I

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and description including ^{land} live stock, notes and accounts as money to be equally divided between my two sons Leon a Hargraves and Barton Hargraves when they become of age only. I desire that my Executors shall use a sufficient amount said property as money to give them a reasonable English education and for their support.

Item fifth. I appoint my beloved Brother John C Hargraves and my worthy friend William A McDonald my executors to this my last will and Testament, having full confidence in their integrity.
