their natural lives or during the time on
each one may remain unmarried, with
the right only of using the rents, issues
and profits for their support. — I further
will and desire that in the event of the
death or marriage of either one of my said
daughters, then the rents, issues and profits
of the property herein given shall be given
to the survivor or one unmarried as long
as she may live or remain single, unmarried,
keeping said property together as a home
and support or trust estate for the benefit
of my said two daughters; I also will that
during the unmarried lives of both or one
of my said daughters, the home place bound-
ed on the west by Kilmore Street, East by
Eades Street, North by lands of one King,
and South by lands of J F Gray, in New
Waycross, Ware County, Georgia, with, members
rights and appurtenances shall be consider-
ed homel for my sons W. C. F. O. H. W. D.
and W. L. Blackshear, and my two said daugh-
ters Love F and Isabella P Blackshear —
and should it occur that my two said
daughters, should marry or die, one or
the other, or both leaving neither of my said
two daughters living or unmarried, then
I direct that the property herein given shall be

divided, share and share alike among
such of my children mentioned in this
Testament that may be living at that time,
in fee simple. —

Item Second. — I hereby constitute and
appoint my son Charles F. Blackshear
Executor of this my last will and Testa-
ment, with instructions to carry out the
provisions of this will; And I especially
charge him to guard the interest of his
two sisters Luc F. and Isabella R. Blackshear.
