will be faithfully and honestly executed. —

4th It is my wish and express desire that my
niece Flonie M Parker and her Husband Orville
D Parker take personal Control of my niece
Hattie M Sydbothen until she has completed
her Education and is fitted to support her-
self. And for the purposes of her Education
I direct that my said Executor W L Carswell
shall take Charge of the rents of my house
and lot in Waycross and pay the same
over monthly to my said niece Flonie M
and her husband Orville D Parker to aid in
the support and Education of her my
said niece Hattie May. After she my
said niece Hattie May had completed her
Education at the age of sixteen years
(if she has done so at said age) she is at
liberty to choose her own home, and when
she arrives at the age of eighteen years
or if she should marry before 1888, living at

and lot in Waycross should be sold by my
before named Executors and the proceeds
thereof be equally divided between my
said Nieces Flomie M Parker and Hattie
May Sydboden. This division I make be-
cause of the fact that the rent of my house
and lot will not pay the expenses of support-
ing and educating my said niece Hattie
May.

5th The provisions in the 4th item above
for the support and Education of my
said niece Hattie May Sydboden is made
on the Condition that her father and
and others interested in her and who might
desire to precise Control over her permit
her to remain under the control of
said Niece Flomie M Parker and her
husband Orville D. ~~Parker in the~~
But in the event she should by any means
be taken from them, then I direct that
my house and lot be immediately sold
by my herein named Executors W J
Leaswell and Orville D Parker and the
proceeds equally divided as I have
herein before directed to wit, between my
nieces Flomie D Parker and the said Hattie
May, the portion thus going to the said
Hattie May to be held in trust for her
by the said W J Leaswell and Orville D
Parker until she shall have arrived at
the age of twenty one years, or shall have
sooner married. —
