and memory, do make and publish this my last  
will and testament, hereby revoking all former  
wills by me at any time heretofore made,  
And as to my worldly estate, and all the property,  
real, personal, or mixed, of which I shall die seized  
and possessed, or to which I shall be entitled at the  
time of my decease, I ~~do~~ devise, bequeath  
and dispose thereof in the manner following, to-wit:  
First, My will is, that all my just debts  
and funeral expense shall, by my executors  
hereinafter named be paid out of my estate,  
as soon after my decease as shall by them  
be found convenient.

Second item, I give and bequeath unto my  
daughter Georgia A. Jones and her children  
(after paying my debts, if any, and funeral expense)  
the whole of my real estate as well as personalty,  
including money, notes and accounts, and all  
other of my property of whatever kind it may be,  
to have and to hold the same, together with all  
the profits and income thereof, to her the  
said Georgia A. Jones and her children,  
to her and their use and benefit forever,  
and in the event that any of the children of  
said Georgia A. Jones should die prior to  
the death of their said mother, leaving a  
child or children living, then I desire said  
child or children so left should stand  
in the place of its or their deceased parent,  
and receive a child's part, that is, the part  
that the deceased parent would have  
taken if living.

And lastly I do nominate and appoint  
my sons P. N. and M. N. Baker to be my  
executors of this my last will and testament.
