Item first; I give bequest and devise to my

to-wit: All the property that I now own,
or may hereafter be possessed of or own, both

survive me.

Item second; At the death of my said wife
Mary, I give devise & bequest to my son
W.B. Thigpen, and my grandson L.A. Thigpen,
the remainder of my estate, of whatever it may
consist at the death of my said wife Mary,
to be equally divided share & share alike
between them the said W.B. Thigpen and L.A.
Thigpen,

Item third; In the event that my said wife
Mary either one of the said W.B. or L.A. Thigpen,
then and in that event the survivor to have
and inherit the whole of said estate so
left by my said wife.

Item 4th; In the event that my said
wife should survive both the said W.B.
& L.A. Thigpen, then and in that event,
she may and shall dispose of said
estate as she may deem best & proper.

Item 5th. I hereby constitute and
appoint my son M.A. Thigpen, executor
of this my last will and testament,
