

In the Name of God. Amen.

1. I, Aaron Greer, of the State of Georgia and County of Thomson, being of sound mind and memory, do make, ordain and declare this instrument to be my last Will and Testament, Revoking all others.
- First - To my Daughter Elizabeth, I give and bequeath the household and Kitchen Furniture, of every sort and kind, which may be on hand, at the time of my decease, with my Bed, furniture and Goods, as also, one Negro Woman, named Hannah, and the use of my dwelling house, for the term of her natural life.
- Second - To my son Robert Greer, I give and bequeath a tract of Land which I show in the Thirtieth District of St. John's, and distinguished in the plan of said District by number one hundred and forty; or also the sum of Five dollars.
- Third - To my grand children Aaron G. Williams and Alexander Williams, I give and bequeath the sum of Four hundred dollars, to be equally divided between them, and to be paid to them by my Executors, as soon as the youngest arrives to the age of Eighteen, and in case either of them should die before the youngest arrives to the age of Eighteen, it is my Will and desire, that the survivor shall take the whole four hundred dollars; and in case they should both die before the youngest arrives to the age of Eighteen, and having no lawful heirs, body, it is my Will and desire, that the said four hundred dollars be equally divided in my Executors or Executors, amongst my sons and daughters.
- Fourth - To my daughter Rachel, or her Heirs, I give and bequeath, her and the heirs of her body, a Negro Woman named Mary, and a Negro Girl, named Alice.
- Fifth - To my son Aaron W. Greer, I give & bequeath the one equal half of the tract of Land whereon I live; as also a Negro Man, named Peter, with one Bed, Bedstead and Furniture, and the one equal half of the Stock of Horses, Cows, Hogs, Plantation Tools of every kind; also four hundred dollars for the purpose of discharging the Legacy contained in the Will of my late son Aaron.
- Sixth - To my son Thomas Greer, I give and bequeath the other
