Warren County, Georgia Wills 1829-1852
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I Anna Moody of the County and State aforesaid Being weak and diseased in Body. But of sound and disposing memory, knowing the uncertainty of life and certainty of death Have thought proper in order to the disposal of such worldly goods and chattels as it hath pleased God to endow me with to make, ordain and establish this my last will and testament.

Item 1st I commend my soul to God and my body to its mother earth to be buried in a decent and christian manner.

Item 2^d It is my will and desire in consideration of the love and affection I have for my daughter Catherine as well as on account of her bad health ~~and~~ inability to support her self by labour that she shall have extra all my household and kitchen furniture (except my Cupboard) and the sum of Fifty dollars in cash the cupboard and all my stock of every description I wish sold the proceeds of which together with what money notes &c that I may die possessed of after the payment of the aforesaid sum of Fifty dollars and my just debts I wish to be equally divided between all my children then and then alike provided nevertheless that in case of the death of my said daughter Catherine prior to marriage or without lawful issue the portion herein bequeath her shall revert to my Estate and be equally divided between her brothers or their children.
