 Oigs and one beaf and furniture, as a part of his
 interest in said estate also the land whereon he now
 lives I wish fully to convey it to him as he has paid
 Me for said Land 3rd I further Order and direct
 That such property as my Executor may think best to be
 disposed of be sold at private sale and the proceeds be
 applied to the payment of the debts 4th I further
 wish that the balance of my estate not sold by my
 Executor be kept together and managed by my Executor until
 my youngest Child comes of age then said estate to be
 divided equally among my Children and wife
 5th I further wish that the lot of Land I drew in the
 Cherokee Gold and Land lottery be sold and the proceeds
 when my youngest Child comes of age to be equally
 divided among my Children & wife
 6th I further wish that all my family live together with my
 son Thomas Allen and all rate at the same table
 7th I hereby appoint Thomas Allen my Executor to
 this my last will and Testament
