

The Last Will & Testament of Benjamin Fletcher  
In the Name of God Amen, I Benjamin Fletcher do  
of Georgia & County of Marion, being in good health, and in  
sound mind & perfect memory, fitt writing to make this my last  
will & testament & hereby do make & ordain binding and  
declare this my last will and testament in manner & form following.  
That is to say... after all my just debts & funeral expences paid then  
it is my intention to make an equally divide among all my  
children as near as lies in my power, body knoweing that first  
of land whereon I now live, & take the tract of land I wanted to  
sell, my lawe exclusive privilage on the said land during our  
natural living and if it shoud please god to continue my life  
with such children in time after my decease, it is my desire that  
she shall hold all the property that I am in possession of at the time  
of my death, during her natural life and it is also my desire

That my wife Judith Wilson be vested with privilege of settling  
 disposing of any such property that appears to be a legacy belonging  
 with the several executors of my worldly & earthly friends and also  
 after the death of my wife Judith Wilson, it is my desire that the  
 land that I now live on with the lands also granted to Wilson  
 to be divided between my two daughters Rosetta Chatter and  
 Rebecca Brown, and nothing that is to say, Beginning at the North  
 corner of my Stevens property on Rockwell road, in Warrens Academy  
 line, running along down said road to the same corner to the South  
 line of said road. All the land belonging to me North of said lines  
 containing three hundred and fifty acres, to be the same more or  
 less, granted in the name of Barbara A. Wilson, it shall be the  
 right of my daughter Rosetta Chatter and the heirs of her  
 body, agreeable to the force in the Testate, and the land lying  
 on the south side of said lines before mentioned that in eight  
 shares, that is to say three hundred and fifty acres more or less,  
 granted in the name of Barbara A. Wilson, in Upton and of which  
 it shall be the right of my daughter Rebecca Brown and the  
 heirs of her body in three shares as not to be subject to her  
 Husband that, for no part of my debts or contracts, and of  
 my desire that the遗产 of Upton let my children have, shall  
 stand over against them in fact of their due and agreeable to  
 the value in money, the title which is now annexed to the execution  
 of my will be given to them both and George, but after the death of  
 myself and my wife Judith Wilson, but not the property that is  
 given and not lost time. That my right standing as a small  
 legacy among all my children, in a manner above that of  
 to each a half Upton, same, there is leaving Upton, Upton,  
 Upton & Rosetta Chatter in two shares, Brown in three  
 and to each of them and their Heirs forever, instruments in my  
 power, and also, I do hereby ordain, constitute & acknowledge  
 my friends, Warrens Robertson, a son in law of mine  
 also a son in law, the surviving Will and Testament, thereby  
 accepting all former gifts by me made, in witness whereof  
 I have set my hand and seal to the above test of the date, 25th  
 January, one thousand eight hundred and thirteen.  
 Signed, sealed & declared by the above named Benjamin Wilson,  
 to be his last Will and Testament, in the presence of my  
 beloved Murray

 Some tract of Land, Eighty Seven hundred & forty 800.  
 1801. Same Murray owns tract of Land, six hundred & fifty Dollars 575.  
 Lucy Murray, Seven hundred and fifty Dollars.  
 1801. Same Murray owns tract of Land, six hundred & fifty Dollars 575.  
 She now owns tract of Land, a half acre.  
 Still remaining in mind Wm & Murray, I think it expedient  
 to make some addition to the above test of the date, 25th January,  
 Wagnleitner give those a legacy, Lucy, a small & young money  
 and to Murray, Murray give those a legacy (as did, Rockley,  
 Johnathan Upton have Negroes, & children, Brownville  
 Lavinia, To Polly Connor, I give those Negroes in old money, the  
 a half of Rosetta Chatter, I give I give those Negroes to  
 Jane, John, & Elizabeth Brown, upon their respective Wives  
 Jerome Murphy, and Two hundred Dollars, to be paid out of money

Murray's part of Legacy, so much her hand of Slavery & color  
all of which property to be owned by herself, from the commence-  
ment of her husband's death to the dying states in the above will be-  
tween in the same manner my last writing to be underneath her above  
named property to my above named children &c during their con-  
tinual living in the Deedshoof, Then for & property to belong to the  
Master of their Deedshoof &c as to me, is to all. Rightly by her of  
the above appointed Executors has removed, I do hereby make  
Edward and Abram Williamson & West, and Abram Williamson  
as above. In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand  
and seal this 20th September 1821
