

The Last Will & Testament of Benjamin Upton

In the Name of God. Amen, I Benjamin Upton of the State
of Georgia & County of Warren, being in good health, and in
sound mind & perfect Memory, but calling to mind the inste-
-bility of life and human affairs do make & ordain, publish and
declare this my last Will and Testament in manner & form follow-
-ing, That is to say, after all my debt is lawfully paid, then
as it is my intention to make and equally divide among all my
children as near as lies in my power, only reserving that Part
of Land whereon I now live, & also the Tract of Land Granted to
Nothing annexed to the same, that I and my beloved Wife Sarah
Upton, may have exclusive privilege on the said Land during our
Natural Lives and if it should please God to continue my beloved
Wife Sarah Upton in Time after my decease, it is my desire, that
she shall hold all the property that I am in possession of at the time
of my death, during her natural life, and it is also my desire,
