

Mr John Browns Will Recorded
 I John Brown of Green County and State of Georgia
 being of sound mind and perfect memory and being
 desirous to make and declare this my last will
 and testament in manner and form following
 to wit I give and bequeath to my Brother Samuel
 Brown of South Carolina the four following Negro
 Boys Oney Jerry and two two Children Abner
 and Elizabeth together with their increase I give
 and bequeath to my Brother William Brown of the
 State of Georgia three Negroes viz Watson Charles
 two sons and one other child to him and his heirs
 together with their increase I give and bequeath
 to John Duke son of my Brother in law recently
 Deceased two Negroes named William & Henry
 I give and bequeath to a girl of color by name
 whom I have lawfully emancipated agreeable to an Act
 passed in the State of Virginia and recorded there
 the four following Negroes to wit Hannah Anthony
 Annimated and Abby, also all my Money Real
 and other I give and bequeath to my Brother
 William Brown my three Children and Duke
 I hereby nominate and appoint Samuel A. Smith
 Executor

Witness my hand and seal this 31st day of January 1845

 at the time of his so doing he was of sound
 disposing mind and memory and was then
 of legal age in his personal and civil
 capacity of such other & became a witness
 to the same in view to the 11th day of
 March 1845
