Come of Age with a house and ~~land~~ to be
Valued to the Amount of Eighty Dollars

3^d And lastly my desire is that my Children
should be maintained out of this Estate until
they Come of Age I also constitute Debra
Chapman And Anne Chapman Executors
of this my last will And testament sealed
with my seal & dated this fifteenth day
of May in the year of our Lord one thousand
Seven hundred And Ninety Eight
