The last Will & Testament of Joel Cloud, deceased,
recorded March 16th 1851 by J. Franklin Clerk, Clerk.

I Joel Cloud of the County of Warren State of Georgia being of sound
mind & disposing memory do make & declare this my last will
and Testament. First I do hereby nominate and appoint
my son Joel Cloud my sole Executor to this my last will
& testament. I secondly I give & bequeath to my said
son Joel Cloud & to his heirs & assigns forever all of that
part of the two tracts of Land Granted to me on 18th & 19th
of March County which lay on the North or North West side
of said Creek the Creek to be the line bounded otherwise by
which I do also give to my said son Joel Cloud his heirs &
assigns all of the tract or parcel of Land which I purchased of
Thomas R. Bowden lying in said County adjoining the lands
above said situated at one hundred & ninety three Acres more
or less granted to James Russell also I give to my said son
Joel Cloud a parcel of land which I purchased of
John Carter of twelve Acres more or less adjoining the last
mentioned also bounded on lands of Parker & Son &c.
I also give my said son Joel an equal share of my
personal estate.

I the Plantations of that part of the two
tracts of Land Granted to me & on which I have been living
on the East or South East side of Hardy Creek I leave to my
Wife & Daughters for a home to live on they are to have
one single and afterwards to be equal divided among them
all & their heirs if they all agree to sell all the rest of the
estate which I may die to be, &c. I give & bequeath
in equal Distribution to all my Children their heirs &c.
the thirds whereof I Joel Cloud have decem-
ber my hand & seal the day of August the 16th Eighteen hundred
& seventeen
