 Death that my property all shall be equally divided between my
 two Grand Daughters Ellen Aldred & Mary Aldred which said
 property consists of four beds & furniture Eleven head of Cattle three
 head of horses One tract of Land Containing one hundred and
 thirty ^{seven} ^{half} Acres more or less granted to James Abbott & party
 further if it is in Will I desire that my beloved son in law
 William Aldred shall live on the Land until my two before
 mentioned Grand Daughters shall be of age otherwise I desire
 that said two tracts of land shall be sold by my Executors
 and the money put out at interest for the benefit of said two
 Children. Further it is my Will that Catharine Childers
 shall have one heifer warbling out of my Stock of Cattle.

And lastly I do ordain Constitute and appoint my
 friend & Son in law William Aldred Executor of this my last
 Will and Testament hereby revoking all other Wills heretofore

 hand & seal this 9th day of May 1851
