Warren County } I Elijah Conner being far advanced in life and having a desire to dispose of such worldly goods as a kind Providence has blessed me with, do hereby make and declare the following to be my last will and testament in manner and form as follows.

Item first, I will and bequeath My soul unto God its Creator in devout belief.

Item 2nd My will and desire is that, after my death that all my just debts be paid as soon as possible after which in consequence of the kind and good attention of My beloved son Elijah Conner in living with me and taking care of me in my old age, and in order to remunerate him for the same I will and bequeath unto him the said Elijah Conner the whole of My estate that I may be possessed of both real and personal of every description whatsoever to him and his heirs forever. I do hereby appoint him the said Elijah Conner Executor to this My last will and Testament hereby revoking all other Wills by me made in Witness whereof I the said Elijah Conner do hereby
