1st This my last will and Testament my will and pleasure is that all my just debts be paid if any there be-

2ndly I give and bequeath unto my beloved son Ezekiel Hilmon one lot or tract of land containing two hundred two and a half acres be the same more or less. Situate lying and being in the County of Muscogee and in the twenty third district and known in plan of said district by number two hundred and forty- and if my son Ezekiel should die and leave no heir of his body then the above mentioned lot or tract of land to be equally divided between my two Grand Sons Samuel H. Simpson and Ezekiel H. Carr-

3rdly I give unto my grand daughter Frances Carr one feather bed two Sheets one County pin and one bed quilt-

4thly I give one bed two Sheets one County pin and one bed quilt to Ellenor Hilmon-

5thly I give one trunk to Frances Simpson and pet-

6thly I give one heifer side to Frances Hilmon-

7thly I give one white cow to Samuel H. Simpson

8thly I give unto my son Ezekiel Hilmon all the rest of my stock of all kind that I have consisting of cattle hogs and sheep &c.-

9thly I appoint Ezekiel Hilmon my executor in testimony whereof I set my hand seal in the presence of three respectable persons this twenty seventh day of June eighteen hundred and thirty two
