

The Last Will & Testament of Francis Parham, dec'd.

Warren County, Georgia Wills 1829-1852

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In the name of God Amen.

I Francis Parham of the State of Georgia

& County of Warren do make constitute & ordain this my last will & testament— Item 1st I will that all my just debts be paid in any way that my executors may deem most proper—

Item 2nd I will my Negro Woman Sarah & her increase if any (except Wayman) to my Daughters Epsy Parham, Sarah Parham, Mariah Antinet Parham & Francis Eliza Parham, to be kept together for the use of these my daughters until the youngest comes of lawfull age or marry, then to be equally divided amongst them share & share alike—

Item 3rd I leave one bed bedstead & furniture to my two daughters between them Vizt. Mariah Antinet Parham & Francis Eliza Parham

Item 4 I give to my son Erastus Parham one bed & furniture, also the one half of my Negro boy Wayman

Item 5 I give & bequeath to my son Nathaniel Parham one half of my negro ^{named} boy Wayman & my black & white work steer—

Item 6 I give all my stock of every sort, and all my household & kitchen furniture to my two sons Nathaniel Parham & Erastus Parham to be equally divided between, that is not otherwise disposed of by this my last Will & Testament

Item 7 I hereby appoint my son Nathaniel Parham my executor to this my last will & testament.
