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knowing that it is appointed unto all men, once to die, I Frances Procter, have thought proper being of a sound mind, and a well disposing memory, to make this my last will and Testament -

First, I commit my soul to the God who gave it me, and my body to be buried in a decent manner -

Item 1st It is my will that my burial expenses be first paid, then all my just debts. -

Item 2nd I give to my son Beder Procter, six negroes (namely) Lane, John, Henrietta, Sam, Carter, and Reuben and their increase, all my stock of cattle, Household and Kitchen furniture except a good bed and furniture a piece for my grand children, James & Frances Procter -

Item 3rd I give to my daughter Feturah bookkey my horse commonly known by the name of Ned -

I hereby appoint my son Beder Procter to carry this my last Will and Testament into effect. And I hereby revoke and disannul all other will or wills whatsoever -

Signed, Sealed &c. on the 13th day of August, in the year of our Lord 1843.
