

Warren County, Georgia Wills 1829-1852
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His Last Will & Testament of Henry Pelties Deceased

State of Georgia In the Name of God Amen
Warren County I Henry Pelties of the County aforesaid do make
and ordain this my last Will & Testament in manner & form
following (Viz)

- To God I recommend my soul & my body to the Earth in decent burial
- First, I wish all my just debts to be paid
- Secondly I give & bequeath to my beloved wife Polly Pelties during her life One tract of land with its improvements containing three hundred Acres more or less purchas'd by me of James Napler adjoining Mr Walker One tract of thirty four Acres more or less adjoining the other tract above mentioned & granted to Jesse Wright with the tract whereon I now live with its improvements containing Three hundred Acres more or less adjoining the first tract above mentioned and other land of my own The Eighteen following Negroes and increase from this day (to wit) Lanny about twenty five years of age Peter Sam the work man Squire and his wife Lucy and Child Augustus York & his wife Phyllis their six children Fanny Clinda Charity Dickey Rhoda Lurany Old Phyllis Old Patsy Old Frank and Randol one pig and Mare Madley two first choice Beds bedsteads & furniture five good Cows & calves five hogs & pigs two Yoke of Oxen & Ox Wagon four Mules one Mahogany Chaireau and one thousand Dollars in Cash and at her Death I wish it divided between her three children Frances Robert C. and Nancy N. Moreland as follows (to wit)
 - One fourth to Frances Moreland and the balance equally share and share alike between Robert C. and Nancy N. Moreland
 - Third & I give my Grand Daughter Clara B. Gittat fifty Dollars Cash which is all I design wish or will she or her representatives ever shall have get or receive of my Estate
 - Fourth = The balance of my estate whether Consisting of lands Negroes good Chattels rights cash or Credits I wish equally divided among my other Grand children not herein mentioned share and share alike that may be living at the time of the distribution
- I hereby Nominate Constitute and appoint my wife Polly Pelties Executrix and my friend Solomon Lockett Executor of this Will last Will & Testament
