

Last Will & Testament of the Rev^d Minder Wilman, Dec^d.

In the Name of God. Amen.

I Minder Wilman, of the State of Georgia, and County of Warren,
am weak in Body, yet of a sound Mind & Memory; do constitute
and make this my Last Will & Testament, in manner and form follow-
ing, that is to say. First. My Will and desire is, that all my just
debts be first paid out of my estate, in such manner as may appear
to my Executor, here after named, may think best.

Secondly. I give and bequeath unto Elizabeth Wilman daughter
of Joshua Wilman, One Negro girl, by the name of Susanah, to
her, and to her Heirs & assigns forever. Provided nevertheless that
if the said Elizabeth should die out this life before she attains the
years of sixteen, then, and in that case, the said Negro girl, shall
return to my estate again.

Thirdly. I give unto Joshua Wilman, all debts & demands he
may be owing me at this time.

Fourthly. I give and bequeath unto Samuel Wilman, my estate
and one half of my Debts, my wife having her first obitice
also the lot of land I showed Public Liberty. Provided he the Samuel
will pay the Office fees, and take out the Grant.

Fifthly. I give and bequeath unto my beloved Wife Gracey
Welman, all the remaining part of my Estate, not already
given unto both Beal and Pughall, or of whatever Nature or Quality
it may, or hereafter be, to her and her heirs & Assigns forever
lastly. I do appoint & ordain my beloved Wife Gracey
Welman Executrix, and Samuel Welman Executor, to carry
into effect this my last Will & Testament; and revoking all
others by me made.

hath set my hand and affixed my Seal, this Twenty fifth day
of October, and in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hun-
dred and Twenty two
