 property with what kind Providence has blessed me
 Do therefore make this my last will and Testament
 hereby revoking all others heretofore made by me
 Item 1st I desire and direct that my body be buried in a
 decent and Christian like manner suitable to my circum-
 stances and conditions in life - My ~~body~~ I trust will
 return to rest with God who gave it, as I hope for
 eternal life through the merits and atonement of the
 blood of our Saviour Jesus Christ whose religion I
 have professed and I humbly trust enjoyed for many
 years.

Item 2nd I desire and direct that all my just debts be
 paid without delay by executor hereinafter appointed
 as I am unwilling my Creditors should be delayed in
 their rights especially as there is no necessity for delay
 Item 3rd I give and bequeath to my son Henry Todd
 Public about fifty years of age and two of his children
 Louisa ten or twelve years of age and Isaac about eight
 or nine years of age

Item 4th I give and bequeath to my son John M. E. Todd
 Mercant and his sucking child

Item 5th I give and bequeath to my son James H. Todd
 all the land that I have in Warren County, Lites a
 man about twenty five years old Nancy about twenty
 years old and her child about a year old, Charlotte Charles
 about fifteen years old

Item 6th I give and bequeath to my son John B. Todd
 Mary a woman about sixteen years old and Moses and
 and Moses and Mary's child Lovely.

Item 7th I give and bequeath to my grand children
 the children of my daughter Nancy deceased
 Adeline eight or ten years old, Washington about eight
 years old and Dick about five years old. The property
 to be given to my daughter Nancy's children to
 be taken care of by my son James H. Todd as
 Agent for the said children, viz. my grand-son

Item 8.th I give and bequeath to my son William Ladd's
children five dollars to be paid to them by James H. Ladd
when the youngest becomes of age. The reason why
I gave none to my son William's children is that
I have given to them their full share heretofore. I also
give to my son James H. Ladd the present growing
crop now to reap all the land to make and gather
said crop. Also I give him three mules and my wagon
and harness and five choice cows and calves and the
sheep - and I give him my household and kitchen
furniture also my tools

Item 9.th I hereby constitute and appoint my son Henry Wood
and James H. Ladd - Executors of this my last will and
Testament. This 15.th April 1847.
