Last Will & Testament of Jesse Bunkley dec'd.

In the Name of God. Amen.

I Jesse Bunkley of the County and State aforesaid being in
dispossession of Body, full of perfect mind and memory, know that
it is appointed unto every man to die, do make and ordain this
my last Will & Testament. First, I give & recommend my
Soul into the hands of Almighty God who gave it to me.

Secondly. My Body I bequeath to a dearest Christian Burial
at the discretion of my Executors. Thirdly. As touching such
worldly effects wherein it hath pleased God to bless me with
in this world, I give and bequeath in the following manner.

First. I lend to my beloved Wife, Eliza Bunkley during
her natural life or widowhood, the following property, to wit:
sixteen Negroes, namely, James, Joshua, Chas., Richard, George,
Rebecca, Bristol, Charles, Pompey, Lewis, David, Betty, Susan,
Jacob, Mary, Bridget, & Susan; and also my interest and share
in negroes, with their future increase, to be equally divided between
Eliza Bunkley, and

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Albert G. Bunkley, Heirs of the said Eliza Bunkley (now Heiress) to
her and the lawfully begotten children of her body; and the
now depending child of Joanna Bunkley, wife of Washington
Bunkley, dec'd. I also lend to my wife, Eliza Bunkley, tract
of land I now dwell on, and the River tract of land I have
and my stock of Horses, Cattle, Sheep, Hogs, Household and
Kitchen Furniture, &c. my Plantation Tools, during her natural
life. In case there is more stock than she can have supplied
a part thereof must be sold for the purpose of paying my just debts
and the present crop of Corn for the use of said Plantations and crop
of Cotton to be sold, and applied to the payment of my just debts.

Secondly. I give & bequeath to my son, Albert G. Bunkley, Heir
of said late James Bunkley and his or, dec'd to me by Jacob
Davenport, and the balance of the tract of land known as John
Bunkley's Tract, dec'd to me by Stephen M. Bunkley, to have
take one hundred and fifty acres. Also, I bequeath to my son
Bunkley all the land that to my wife, Eliza Bunkley at her death.
