

In the name of God. Amen.

I John Hyman of the State of Georgia (and County of Warren, Planter, being sick in body, but in perfect mind and memory, blessed be God for it, but calling to mind, the mortality of the body, and knowing that it is appointed once for man to die, do make and ordain this my last Will & Testament; First I recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty God, that gave it, and my body to be decently buried at the discretion of my Executors. As for the goods it has pleased Almighty God to bless me with, I give in the following manner, viz:

I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary Hyman one bed and furniture of her choice.

I give and bequeath unto my daughter Harriet Hyman one bed & furniture.

I give and bequeath unto the four children of my son Aaron Hyman the value of One Bed & furniture.

I give and bequeath unto my son Henry Hyman the value of One bed and furniture, by his taking the cow & calf that he now has as a part of that value.

I give and bequeath unto my son William Hyman enough of my estate to make him equal with the rest, viz. to one bed and furniture. I also wish that these gifts do not take place until the death of my wife Roda Hyman, unless she of her own free will give them.

I wish as much of perishable estate be sold by my Executors as will pay my just and lawfull debts, and also the balance or residue of my Estate to remain in possession of my wife Roda Hyman during her natural life, except she shall at any time be known to be extravagantly wasting it, then to be taken into the hands of my Executors, and a reasonable support dealt out to her; and after her death what remains of any estate not willed, to be sold, and the proceeds equally divided, viz: One eighth part to the heirs of Elizabeth Norris; One eighth part to the heirs of Abner Smith, and eighth part to the heirs of Aaron Hyman, one eighth part to the heirs of Martha Maxwell; One eighth part to Henry Hyman; one eighth part to William Hyman, One eighth part to Mary Hyman; and one eighth part to Harriet Hyman.

And last of all I nominate and appoint my well beloved son in law Samuel Smith and my well beloved son William Hyman my Executors to this my last will and Testament, making null & void all other wills by me

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made, and declaring this and no other to be my last Will and Testament, I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this the 18th day of November 1831.
