 not give sell or otherwise convey any part or the
 whole of the same to any person or persons except
 my own Children or grandchildren and giving her
 the privilege of making my Bedchamber and
 with any bed stock I shall leave
 bound to her in the name of the family as long as
 living forever in case of my death leaving
 containing your hundred & forty acres, Ninety eight
 two in the white & fifteen with trees, hundred and
 each to be divided between her young after my Death
 this to give my Daugt'r Susanna Dartmouth

 Give my Son Paul McCormick the balance
 of my Thousand Survey of land which lies on the
 said Side of the River and on the opposite Side
 of the River never to have it to take forever
 Fifth: Give my Daughter Anna Lucy with
 her Husband on the North Side of the land belonging
 to the River never to have it sold or otherwise
 disposed of among my Grand Children sons & daughters
 of my Body (to her) & such heirs as
 may be born, along with her increase, to her
 & to hold forever forever the said Negro Woman
 Mary McDonald in the proportion and shares of my
 daughter Polly Davis holding my natural
 and full proportion of land same as before
 to share the said Negro Woman's proportion after
 my own death and at her Death upon this
 subject to distribution among my Grand
 Children.

eventually your son equally divided between them
 as is written in my first Will
 I leave to McCormick Anna Daugther over her
 all the rest of my Estate whether of
 good chattels right credits lands or otherwise
 unengaged in her as one tenth of land in the said
 tract of land in this County Number one
 hundred and six other number two hundred and
 seven in the thirteenth District Early County
 Number Ninety two in the tenth District of
 Early County.
