 Isaac, Washington, Tully, Warren & all together with the house & kitchen
 furniture & the lot of all kinds of stock & Blacksmiths tools, during her widow-
 hood as a provision, the giving to my sons, Richard, James and William,
 as they arrive at a full man's house each, one hundred & provisions, and the other
 furniture in the name of my children have already deceased at his discretion
 I do hereby give and bequeath unto my beloved Daughter, Mrs. George
 Lewis in the name of Thomas, together with the other property which
 has already in possession, to her and her heirs and assigns forever.
 And I do hereby give and bequeath unto my beloved son Thomas, one
 lot of land in Talbot County which he bought of Henderson.
