I Joel Blaud of the County of Warren State of Georgia being of sound mind & of legal memory do make & ordain this my last Will and Testament. First I do hereby nominate and appoint my son Joel Blaud my sole Executor to this my last Will & Testament. Secondly I give & bequeath to my said son Joel Blaud & to his heirs & assigns forever all of that part of the two tracts of Land granted to me on Harts Creek Warren County which lays on the North or North West side of said Creek the Creek to be the line bounded otherwise by Robert H. I also give to my said son Joel Blaud his heirs & assigns all of the tract or parcels of Land which I purchased of Thomas Bondre laying in said County adjoining the lands aforesaid estimated at one hundred & ninety three Acres more or less granted to James Baswell also I give to my said son Joel Blaud his heirs & assigns a parcel of land which I purchased of John Parker of twelve Acres more or less adjoining the last mentioned tract also bounded on lands of Parker Hoge &c I also give my said son Joel an equal Child's part of my personal estate. I The Plantations & that part of the two tracts of Land granted to me & on which I now live laying on the East or South East side of Harts Creek I leave to my single Daughters for a home to live as they or any of them live single and afterwards to be equally divided among them all & their heirs if they all agree to sell all the rest & residue of the estate which I may die possessed of I give & bequeath in equal Distribution to all my Children their Heirs &c In Witness whereof I Joel Blaud have hereunto set my hand & seal the day of August the 16 Eighteen hundred & seventeen
