County of Warren, I Joel Norris being Weak in body
but of sound mind and knowing the uncertainty of
life do make and Ordain this my Last Will and
Testament. I do Will (and Ordain) that all my just
debts be paid out of the proceeds of the crop now
growing and I bequeath all the rest of my estate
to my Loving Wife James Norris to have and to hold
for as long as she lives and at her death I will
that whole Estate shall be turned into money and that
the Equally divided among all my Children August 29th
1833
