 including a head and foot stone to my grave I bequeath to the Church
 of the Purification of the R & Mary Locust Grove Warren County Georgia
 one hundred dollars I bequeath also to the Contingent fund of said
 church the sum of five dollars. I also bequeath to the Rev Peter Wholahan
 Pastor of said church the sum of twenty dollars and the ballance of
 my estate to my son Andrew Wholahan.

I constitute and appoint Hugh Eldred of said county and state
 Executor to this my last will and Testament.
