 of the Purification of the B & M Mary Society Grose Warren County Georgia  
 one hundred dollars I bequeath also to the Contingent fund of said  
 church the sum of five dollars. I also bequeath to the Rev Peter Whalan  
 Pastor of said church the sum of twenty dollars and the ballance of  
 my estate to my son Andrew Whalan.

I constitute and appoint Joseph T. Ladd of said County and State  
 Executor to this my last will and Testament.
