I Levi Mcbray of the county aforesaid do make and ordain this my last will and Testament in manner and form following to wit

To God I commend my soul and my body to the earth in decent burial.  
And my temporal goods I give.

First. To my Executor I wish him to pay all my Just debts.

Second. I give my brother Jasper Mcbray my shot gun and my two chests

Third. I give to Levi Mcbray son of my brother Asa one hundred dollars to be raised out of my estate and remained in the hands of my Executor free of interest and <sup>paid</sup> when he comes of age.

Fourth. I give my brothers Jasper Mcbray Isaac Mcbray Ezra Mcbray and Asa Mcbray all The balance of my estate of what ever name or nature to be equally divided share and share alike.

I hereby nominate constitute and appoint my Brother Asa Mcbray Executor of this my last Will and Testament.

The 22<sup>th</sup> day of April Eighteen hundred and forty five.
