some part in consideration of the certainty of death, and the uncertainty
of the time thereof, and to the end I may be the better prepared
to leave this world whenever it shall please God to call me home,
do therefore make and declare this my last will & Testament in

 sum of legacies give her as an evidence of my ransom-
 -brances, and in consequence of the provision herein
 after made, for her own Folding Vails.

Frank Reed and Hannah Reiter, my daughters, and
Eveling Hall, my Grandson and their respective heirs, I give
and bequeath, to be divided share and share alike among
them, the following: Nine Negroes, viz Young Brantley and
her three children, Clara, Paul and Edward, Winney's three
children, Rees and Emma, Jordan and Young Ben:
chargeable therewith, with the payment of the several
debts & legacies herein before bequeathed to my sons, John
Brantley and his heirs, my daughter Catherine Pratt
and her heirs, and my daughter Anne Wright, her heirs;
which said ^{several} legacies it is my will and desire my Executor
should discharge previous to the delivering of said Negroes
to the heirs to whom they are bequeathed.
