 of benefitting this my last will & testament, & to
 it to be the same by all as just
 In the first place I recommend to you who
 gave it to my body to be recently buried
 according to the direction of my last will
 & testament, I will & bequeath to you
 that shall my will be paid
 I have I give to my son Edward Pinson
 forty shillings of both in hand with two
 pounds for me on each day & next Sunday
 the right for one hour with the
 power of giving off one shilling & four pence
 five pence one shilling one pence five pence
 I do constitute & appoint John Lofson my
 executor to this my last will & testament
 & I do further in me make all void by
 me or any one on my side & acknowledge
 this to be my last will & testament in writing
 in the year 1798
 I have signed & sealed this in the day of month
 the year 1798
 Thomas Jones

I, Thomas Jones, do hereby

 & oath & said, on his oath that the within
