1st Item first, I give to my son in Law, George W. Hillman five
dollars and no more.

2nd I give to my daughter Evaline Hillman's children, namely
Cecilia Ann Hillman, Roanna Hillman, William Henry
Harrison Hillman and Coalman W. Hillman, twenty five dollars
each to be paid them by my Executors as they arrive at lawful age.

3rd All the balance of my estate, whether consisting of lands,
negroes, cash, stock, debts due, or any other thing or things
whatsoever, I give to be equally divided among my living sons
viz: I Elias Ivy, Oliver Ivy, Lazarus Ivy, Zachary Ivy, Brady-
ord Ivy, Levi Ivy, Jephtha Ivy and Joel Ivy, share and share
alike.

4th I nominate, constitute and appoint my two sons Zachary
Ivy and Lazarus Ivy, Executors to this my last Will and
Testament.
